Nature and Scope dinvestigation:

To determine whether any consummated mergequisition or transaction any persons, partnerships, corporations, or others with a current enterprise value of over \$5 billion is in violation of Section 7 of the Clayton Act, 15 U.S.C. § 18, as amended, or Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. § as amended; and to determine whether the requirements of the Claytor Act, 15 U.S.C. § 18 after fulfilled with respect to saidtransaction.

The Federal Trade Commission hereby solves and irects that any and all compulsory processes vailable to the used in connection ith these investigations for a period not to exceed tenyears. The expiration of this type ar period shall not limit or terminate the investigation or the legal effect of any compulsory process issued during the attemption. The Federal Trade Commission specifically authorithe filing or continuation of actions to enforce any such compulsory process after the expiration of the attemption.
