Re: Unsubstantiated Claims for Coronavirus Prevention or Treatment

To Whom It May Concern,

This is to advise you that FTC staff has reviewed your website at <u>http://loveacu.net/</u> on May 12, 2020. We have determined that you are unlawfully advertising that certain products treat or prevent Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).include:

- In marketing materials accessible from your homepage through a link titled "Alternative treatments for COVID-19 (coronavirus)," you claim:
 - That "[i]n the Chinese history, whenever a plague is rampant, Chinese medicine practitioners are always on the front lines to battle the disease. Many survived with the help of Chinese Medicine; so in this fight with the insidious and novel virus, Chinese Medicine once again should take a primary role in effective treatment and must not be absent in action!"
 - That "the Chinese government distributed Chinese herbal medicine to everyone with covid-19 in the hospital and at yi

person's ability to mount an essential immune response to the virus. The results in China are positive!"

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stressed, we are staying iviginary and mindful of the deverpments with the COVID-19 virus that seems be spreading in our area."

It is unlawful under the TC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 4et seq. to advertise that a product can prevent, treat, or cuheman disease unless you possess competent and reliable scientific evidence, includingyhen appropriate, well-confled human clinical studies, substantiating that the claimase true at the time they amade. For COVID-19, no such study is currently known to exist for the protaid entified above. Thus, any Coronavirusrelated prevention or treatment claimgareding such products are not supported by competent and reliable scientific evidence what immediately cease making all such claims.

You are also advised tovie w all other claims for your products and immediately cease making claims that are not supported by etempand reliable scientific evidence.
