RE: Unapproved and Misbranded Products Related to Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)

This is to advise you that the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) reviewed your website at the Internet address <https://canadianchaga.com> on July 25, 2020, and August 3, 2020, respectively. The FDA has observed that your website offers “124 Chaga Capsules,” “Chaga Tea,” and “Canadian Chaga Tincture” (hereinafter referred to as “Chaga products”) for sale in the United States and that these products are intended to mitigate, prevent, treat, diagnose, or cure COVID-19¹

- € “GOOD NEWS! WE HAVE SOME CHAGA AVAILABLE NOW! FEATURED PRODUCTS ARE LIMITED DUE TO THE EXTRMELY HIGH DEMAND FROM THE SPREAD OF CORONA VIRUS. PEOPLE SAY THEY WANT IT SO THEY CAN PROTECT THEMSELVES.”
- € “Chaga is believed to be one of the highest antioxidants you can get and guess what that means it may fight against Corona-virus and or cancer. I am taking my Chaga everyday so I hopefully don't get controlled by a virus. . .”

You should take immediate action to correct the violations cited in this letter. This letter is not meant to be an all-inclusive list of violations that exist in connection with your products or operations. It is your responsibility to ensure that the products you sell are in compliance with the FD&C Act and FDA's implementing regulations. We advise you to review your website, product labels, and other labeling and promotional materials to ensure that you are not misleadingly representing your products as safe and effective for a COVID-19-related use for which they have not been approved by FDA and that you do not make claims that misbrand the products in violation of the FD&C Act.
